

VERBS TO USE AND AVOID

learn·ing ob·jec·tive:

A measurable and observable statement of what learners will be able to do once they have completed the learning experience successfully.

Example: "The trainee will be able to **demonstrate** the I-E-E-I method."



VERBS TO USE

(observable & measurable)

Lower Cognitive Level

answer orally choose clean complete construct define draw explain find identify

access adjust apply collect comply conduct

demonstrate develop document express

Higher Cognitive Level

ascend & descend assign calculate classify compute correct create describe in writing differentiate explain orally





VERBS TO AVOID

(vague, not behavioral or measurable)

appreciate
be acquainted with
be aware of
enjoy
gain a working knowledge of

grasp the significance of learn recognize remember understand
